Students may bring in items any time between now and November 12th. It is suggested that each box have a WOW toy such as a doll, soccer ball with pump, or stuffed animal to bless a child. Other items to include are hygiene items and school supplies. Examples being playing cards, batteries (in original packaging or with both ends taped), toy spiders/bugs/snakes, superheroes or other licensed characters, scissors, compact mirrors, Chapstick, play dough, deodorant, makeup (non-liquid), adhesive bandages, eating utensils, marbles, Bibles or other religious literature or symbols. **DO NOT SEND:** Scary items (things that will frighten a child), war-related items (such as toy soldiers, military vehicles, toy weapons or wearable camouflage), liquid paint sets, liquid glue, rubber balls with liquid filling, liquid lip gloss, food, candy, gum, toothpaste, nail polish, money or play money, liquids, lotions, breakable items, glass containers, aerosol cans, used clothing or used toys.
